December 15th marks the last Town Council meeting of 2023! The past year has *flown* by, and we've accomplished quite a bit this year. As part of our ongoing commitment to keep you informed of town happenings, here are just a few of the topics that are up for discussion for this month's meeting.

Parking regulations will be up for discussion and a possible vote. The discussion will include a variety of potential scenarios, including but not limited to a cost increase of the parking permits and/or meter rates, a change to the duration of the parking season, and/or a change to the free parking days/times.

Our **beach patrol** captain will also provide a report regarding the 2023 summer season. This is a great recap on all of the DBP successes, and also a time to review what needs improvement for 2024.

Dogs on the beach will be up for discussion as well. Our current summer season runs from May 15th – Sept 15th, during which dogs are not prohibited on the beach from 9:00a – 5:00p. Current lifeguard duty runs from Memorial Day to Labor Day. New legislation could potentially allow dogs to enjoy the beach during summer season daytime hours, when no lifeguard is present.

As always, topics are up for discussion and a potential vote. We welcome your thoughts during the public comment portion of the meeting. You may also submit your thoughts to Town Council directly in advance of the meeting. For more information on the topics up for discussion. visit the town meeting calendar. SAFETY & REGULATIONS

The goal of town staff is to welcome all of our visitors, protect the public, and ensure safe travel back to their destination at the end of the evening. Safety is a shared responsibility.

- Start 2024 off right! Have a travel plan, and stick to it. At the time of publishing, rideshare promo codes have not yet been released. We recommend keeping an eye on <u>Lyft</u> and <u>Uber</u>, as NYE promo codes are sometimes offered. Don't forget you can schedule ahead with rideshare companies. Reserve your ride today.
- Local hotels and residential rentals have great rates in the off-season. Don't drive... stay with us! There's nothing better than waking up at the beach.
- Dewey Beach maintains a <u>curfew</u> for minors year round. Persons under the age of 18 must be off the street by
 11:00pm each evening. While we pride ourselves on being a family-friendly destination, in the late evening hours,
 most businesses cater to crowds 21 and over. For the safety of our younger visitors, parents should ensure their
 children are at their home or rental by 11:00pm.
- The Dewey Beach Police will be out and about throughout New Years Eve and New Years Day. We're here to keep you safe! If you see suspicious behavior or require assistance, please call 911 or alert an officer directly.
- As always, while you're here, you're a member of the Dewey Beach family. Look out for one another. If you notice
 a person that may require assistance, confront them, and ask if they need help. Recruit support from business
 employees or police when necessary.
