
Synopsis of The Municipal Code for The Town of Dewey Beach Summer Season (May 15th—September 15th)

- No open alcoholic beverages are allowed in public, including the beach.
- Smoking is prohibited on the beach/beach dunes and in town parks.
- ♦ The beach is open from 5:30a—1:00a.
- Surf fishing is permitted on the beach. You
 must ensure you are not within 100 feet of
 bathers if you are fishing between the hours of
 10:00a—5:00p.
- No private vehicles are allowed on the beach.
- Glass bottles and containers are prohibited on the beach.
- No commercial activity is allowed on the beach or public streets without approval from the Town.
- Please respect Dewey Beach and help us to keep it beautiful! Littering is subject to fines.
- Sporting activities on the beach are limited between the hours of 11:00a—3:00p on weekends and holidays. Check with a lifeguard prior to engaging in sporting activities.
- For your safety and the safety of fellow beachgoers, launching and swimming to and from boats is prohibited.
- Sleeping in vehicles is prohibited.
- Residential occupancy limits are 2 persons per bedroom, plus a maximum of 2 additional persons allowed in a general living area.

Parking in Dewey Beach

Parking permits and parking meters are in effect May 15—September 15 as follows:

Handicap Parking Tags

Handicap license plates and placards are valid to use as a permit at ALL permit and metered spots, but must be visibly displayed.

Dewey Beach Parking Permit Fees

- ♦ Seasonal: \$250
 - Applicable Discounts
- Dewey Beach Property or In-Town Business Owner: Up to 2 at \$150 each (beach tax must be paid; must not owe any parking ticket fees)
- Business Licensed to Work in Dewey: Up to 2 at \$200 each.
- Direct Employee of a Dewey Beach Business: Up to 2 at \$200 each.
- ♦ Weekly (8 Consecutive Days): \$75
- ♦ One Day (Mon, Tues, Wed): \$15
- ♦ One Day (Thurs, Fri, Sat, Sun): \$20
- ♦ Weekend (Fri, Sat, Sun): \$45

Seasonal parking permits are available for purchase at
Town Hall. Weekly and weekend permits can be
purchased at the kiosk outside of the Town Hall building.
Daily permits are also available at the kiosk, or through
the Park Mobile app.

Parking permit holders may park in zone 4012 (signage marked throughout town). Parking permits are NOT VALID for use at parking meter spots.

Dewey Beach Parking Meters

Park Mobile is available for use at all parking meters throughout town. There are 3 ways to use Park Mobile:

- 2. Visit www.parkmobile.com
- 3. Call the toll-free number on the meter signs

Handicap Beach Wheelchairs

Beach wheelchairs are available to rent for free on weekends between May 1—May 28 and daily from May 29—September 13. To reserve a wheelchair, visit www.townofdeweybeach.com.

Curfew for Minors

No minor shall remain in or upon any public place between the hours of 11:00p—5:00a of the following day, except on Fridays and Saturdays when curfew hours shall be from 12:00a—5:00a.

Disorderly Houses

Violations may lead to a tenant's eviction, and the property owner could be subject to loss of their rental license. To report a disorderly house or noise emanating from a commercial establishment, call the Dewey Beach Police Dept. at (302)227-1110.

Dogs

Dogs must be licensed with the town, and are not allowed on the beach between the hours of 9:30a—5:30p from May 15—Sept 15. Owners must clean up after their dog. Dog licenses may be purchased at Town Hall, or online at www.townofdeweybeach.com.

Bonfires

Fires are allowed on the beach with a permit. Permits must be obtained in person at Town Hall.

Weddings

Weddings are permitted on the beach with prior approval from Town Hall. Visit www.townofdeweybeach.com for more information.
